IMPORTANT - READ THESE TERMS CAREFULLY.

BY USING THIS PRODUCT (DEFINED BELOW), YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU HAVE READ, UNDERSTAND AND THAT YOU AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THE TERMS OF THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THE TERMS OF THIS LICENSE AGREEMENT, DO NOT USE THE PRODUCT. THE TERM "YOU" AS USED HEREIN REFERS TO THE END-USER OF THE PRODUCT AND MAY INCLUDE NATURAL PERSONS, A CORPORATE ENTITY(IES) AND EMPLOYEES THEREOF.

1. Grant of License for Users

This License Agreement is an agreement between YOU and NIELSEN MEDIA RESEARCH, INC. ("NIELSEN MEDIA") that sets forth YOUR rights and obligations with respect to the Nielsen SpOTTrac Encoder Application (the "Software") resident within the SpOTTrac Encoder purchased by YOU under separate agreement, as well as to any explanatory materials or files ("Documentation"), and any data that is produced by the SpOTTrac Encoder (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Product"). The Product is owned or licensed by NIELSEN MEDIA or one of its suppliers and is copyrighted and/or patented and licensed, not sold, to YOU by NIELSEN MEDIA for use only under the terms of this License Agreement, and NIELSEN MEDIA reserves all rights not expressly granted to YOU.

NIELSEN MEDIA hereby grants YOU a non-exclusive, non-transferable, limited license to install and use the Product, in machine-executable form only, on a pre-configured SpOTTrac Encoder solely for YOUR internal business purposes, provided that: (i) YOU may NOT modify the Product; (ii) YOU maintain all identifying marks, copyright and proprietary notices on the Product; and (iii) YOU agree to be bound by the terms of this License Agreement. A replacement fee may be required for out-of-warranty products. YOU are prohibited from installing and/or using the Product or attempting to install and/or use the Product on any other equipment other than a pre-configured SpOTTrac Encoder.

NIELSEN MEDIA, ITS AFFILIATES OR ITS DESIGNATED PRODUCTION DISTRIBUTOR may, at its sole discretion, provide bug fixes or patches, error corrections, updates, conversions or technical support of the Product or for otherwise maintaining the Product.
